# **WHAT TO BRING:**

- Valid ID/Drivers License
- Valid Hunting License & Tags
- Migratory Game Bird Endorsement
- HIP certification.
- Federal Duck Stamp

- Appropriate firearm & ammo
- Waders, cold-season gear, & ear protection.
- Proper storage/ transportation for meat after cleaning.

# **RULES & EXPECTATIONS:**

- **REGARDING DOGS:**Our guides have trained duck dogs, however we will allow personal duck dogs in private groups of 4+ people. We are not responsible for anything that may happen to it, and you are expected to have full control of your dog while on our property. Honey Rock Bottoms cannot ensure a quality hunt if a personal duck dog is involved. Groups smaller than 4 will not be allowed personal dogs to ensure a quality hunt for the rest of the group.
- You are expected to have all required hunting documentation on your person at all times.
- Cooperation with local game wardens is expected, failure to cooperate will result in immediate expulsion from property.

• You will meet at designated time & location. Guide will transport you to the blind and set up decoys 30 min. prior to shooting light.
