

DEER HUNTER INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING:

- Valid ID/Drivers License
- Valid Hunting License & Tags
- Appropriate firearm & ammo
- Appropriate hunting attire/ shoes based on forecasted weather.
- Cooler to store harvest after cleaning/field dressing

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- You will not be driven to blind/stand so the deer are not startled. Expect to walk to final hunting destination.
- Be aware of the forecasted temperatures and weather conditions.
- 15-30 minute target practice will be required before scheduled hunt.
- Morning Hunts: You will be in the blind/stand 30-45 minutes before sunrise

SERVICES PROVIDED:

- Our guides are all knowledgable and will provide you with the best estimates and experience they can.
- Guides will assist in field dressing any harvest during hunt.
- Transportation to and from initial hunting location. (You will have to walk with guide to blind/stand.)
